Since December 2021 she is chairwoman of the Parliamentary Group Alliance 90/The Greens in the German Bundestag. Previously, she was spokeswoman for economic policy and parliamentary secretary of the Parliamentary Group Alliance 90/The Greens. From 2013 to 2021 she was member of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Energy of the German Bundestag.

After the federal elections of 2021, she was member of the exploratory talks and head of the negotiation group on labor and deputy head of the negotiation group on economy between the Green Party, Social Democrats (SPD) and Free Democratic Party (FDP).

Katharina Dröge graduated from the University of Cologne in 2010 with a diploma in Economics.

She worked as an advisor at the Ministry for Climate Protection, Environment, Agriculture, Nature Conservation and Consumer Protection of the state of North Rhine-Westphalia.
